

Greyhound Channel Track of the Week Handicapping Contest & Challenge

The handicapping contest will be held every Saturday during the year. The winner of the contest will have a chance to double his or her winnings by competing against a Greyhound Channel handicapper on the following Monday.

Contest Rules:

- There are no entry fees.
- All active (opening deposit made) Greyhound Channel account holders with a valid e-mail address will be eligible to compete.
- Submit your selections [HERE](#). The account number must be included on the entry form, or the entry will NOT be considered a valid entry.
- Only one entry per account is permitted. If more than one entry is submitted, with different selections, BOTH entries will be disqualified.
- This handicapping contest is meant to be a test of skill and effort. In order to further that goal, any entries with the same runner number picked for every race will be disqualified.
- Greyhound Channel has the right to disqualify any entry that is obviously attempting to subvert any of the rules of the contest.
- The contest winner will have \$100.00 entered into their Greyhound Channel wagering account. The winner will also be invited to compete in the handicapping challenge on Monday.
- The second thru fifth place finishers will receive bonus points towards wager credits and merchandise, redeemable through our Greyhound Channel contest site in the following amounts: 2nd = 2,500pts, 3rd = 1,500 pts, 4th = 1,000 pts, 5th = 500 pts (you must be registered on the [Greyhound Channel contest site](#) to receive bonus points)
- All selections must be made at the selected "contest" track. The track will be chosen from our list of available tracks offered by Greyhound Channel, and will be posted on the Greyhound Channel web site no later than the Wednesday preceding the contest.
- All selections must be entered at least 15 minutes prior to post time of the first race at the contest track.
- Each contestant will select only one greyhound in each race at the contest track.
- A contestant will receive points on the basis of the \$2.00 win, place, and show mutuel payoffs on the greyhound selected. Example 1: \$2 Win pays \$5.40, \$2 Place pays \$3.20, \$2 Show pays \$2.40, so the contestant receives 1100 points. Example 2: \$2 Place pays \$3.60, \$2 Show pays \$3.00, so the contestant receives 660 points. Example 3: \$2 Show pays \$5.40, so the contestant receives 540 points.
- Maximum points for Win = 4200, maximum points for Place = 2200, maximum points for Show = 1000.
- If there is no mutuel payout for the selection, the contestant will be awarded maximum points for each position with no payout.
- The contestant with the most points at the end of the race-day will be the winner.

- In the unlikely event of a tie, the prize money will be divided equally among the winners and each contestant will be allowed to compete to double their money on Monday.
- If no selection is made for any race, the contestant will receive 0 points for that race.
- If the greyhound selected is scratched, the contestant will receive 600 points for that race.
- Bonus rewards must always be wagered once prior to withdrawal
- Greyhound Channel management, whose decisions are binding in every respect, will handle all disputes. Prizes may not be substituted for or transferred to another account holder. The winner will be notified by e-mail on the Sunday following the contest, as well as published on the track of the week page.

Handicapping Challenge Rules:

- The contest winner(s) from Saturday will be asked to select one greyhound from the 15th race at Palm Beach on Monday (An alternate track may be substituted, if necessary).
- The selection must be made via e-mail before the post time for the first race of the Matinee.
- The Greyhound Channel handicapper will then choose one greyhound from the remaining runners in that race. That selection will be e-mailed to the contest winner(s), before the post time of the first race of the Matinee.
- If the contest winner's selection is scratched, the contestant will receive the wagering favorite and the Greyhound Channel handicapper will receive the second wagering favorite for that race.
- The winner of the challenge will be decided on a head-to-head basis. If the contest winner's selection finishes ahead of the Greyhound Channel handicapper's selection, they will be declared the winner of the challenge and will win an additional \$100.00.

Legal and Eligibility:

Employees, officers and directors (and their immediate families [parents, children, spouses and siblings] regardless of where they live and members of their same households [whether related or not]) of Greyhound Channel, its parent company, are not eligible.
